

# **PELORUS VINTAGE 2012**

Vibrant and well-toned, Pelorus 2012 is laden with rich custard, bright citrus and toasty brioche. The nose is vibrant, with lemon curd-like citrus notes, wildflowers and pasties de nata. The taut and toned palate has mellowed with age, but keeps its bright, mouthwatering acidity. Citrus, crunchy red apples and toasted almonds come wrapped in notes of toasted, warm brioche.

### **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2022**

The 2022 Sauvignon Blanc has a zesty and vibrant nose, with notes of juicy citrus and makrut lime underpinned by subtle white nectarine and passionfruit notes. The palate is mouthwatering, with ripe vibrant passionfruit and citrus at the fore. These meld with tropical hints of peach and guava, gently balanced by stony saline notes.

# **CHARDONNAY 2020**

The 2020 Chardonnay is a welcoming burst of warmth and intensity. The nose is immediately open and appealing, with notes of white peach, apricot, ripe citrus and warm hay. A squeeze of ripe lemon freshens an intense palate of yellow stone fruit framed by mouthwatering saline acidity. Gentle notes of toast provide a savoury backbone to the luscious fruit, providing moreish balance.

#### **PINOT NOIR 2018**

Elegant and complex, the Pinot Noir 2018 is darkly fragrant, with notes of black cherry and spice. On the palate, a core of

# CALVERT 2018 (Central Otago, Pinot Noir)

Open and expressive on the nose, with notes of wild berries and garrigue-like characters in the glass. The palate is concentrated, with a core of rose-hip and cherry fruit, framed by quite robust, but well integrated tannins. Long on the finish, with linger notes of wild thyme.

### **SYRAH 2019**

Immediately aromatic and appealing on the nose, with notes of black berry fruits, spice and woodsmoke. The palate is dense and concentrated, with mouthwatering acidity balancing ripe plum and bramble fruit. Long on the finish, with a touch of black pepper lingering.
