

# CLOUDY BAY

## PELORUS ROSE

Pelorus Rosé is smooth and elegant, with a pale salmon hue and brambly aromas. The nose is laden with raspberries, cranberries and wild strawberries, while red florals, rosehip and marzipan hover at the fringe. Baked quince, cranberry and brioche meet citrus notes on the palate, while its fine structure persists all the way to a soft, dry finish.

## SAUVIGNON BLANC 2023

The 2023 Sauvignon Blanc has an enticing nose, with appealing aromas of ripe honeydew melon, passionfruit, vibrant citrus and a subtle touch of fresh blackcurrant leaf. The palate is concentrated and elegant, with hints of fresh sea air balancing out the warmth of the ripe fruit notes at the wine's core. Subtle tropical fruit characters are underpinned by freshening notes of makrut lime, lemongrass, Meyer lemon and a touch of grapefruit skin.

## TE KOKO 2021

Te Koko 2021 initially closed on the nose but unfurls with notes of subtle tropicality, honey and graphite.

The palate is extraordinarily complete, with complex layers of peach, preserved citrus and toasted nuts. A fine line of acidity and an enticing saline minerality balance the intense core of fruit and provide a fresh, palate-cleansing finish.

## CHARDONNAY 2021

Open on the nose, with expressive notes of stone fruit, orchard blossoms and subtle crème pâtissière and hazelnut notes. The palate is taut and vibrant, with mouthwatering citrus freshness framing a core of conference pear and white nectarine. There is a touch of well-integrated toasty oak, melding with layers of savoury texture and leading into a long and elegant finish.

## PINOT NOIR 2021

The Pinor Noir 2021 is incredibly pretty and enticing on the nose, with notes of boysenberry, cherry and fragrant, dusky florals. On the palate, crunchy dark cherry, cranberry and hedgerow fruit notes burst in the mouth and bring an immediate sense of freshness. The tannins are super-fine, effortlessly underpinning the intense and succulent fruit character.

## DELTA 2020 *(Marlborough)*

Taking a while to unfurl in the glass, with time this offers notes of cedar-spice, red cherry and wild strawberry. On the palate, this is vibrant with concentrated crunchy red berry fruit and a taut tannic frame, leading through to a refreshing finish.
